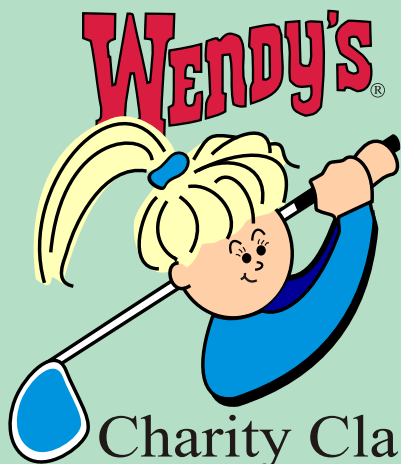

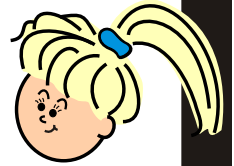
An invitation to the party is automatic to amateur players and LPGA pros, of course, but even if you don't play golf, you can be a part of this year's sware' by participating as a sponsor.

About the Live Auction

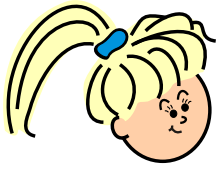

About the Tournament

The pro-am features one LPGA professional per four amateurs, forming teams of five who play 18 holes in a scramble format. Everyone tees off, the team selects the best ball to play, everyone hits their second shot from that position and so forth. Prizes are awarded to the top three teams, and the event is handicapped. Amateurs are asked to supply a handicap upon registration. A champion's trophy is also awarded to the first place team's LPGA professional. Defending champions include Jane Crafter (1999) and AmyFruwirth (2001).

About the Course

The Country Club of Jackson is located at 3135 Horton Road in Jackson, Michigan and presents 27 beautifully manicured holes. Recognized by *Michigan Links Magazine* as one of the finest private club courses in Michigan (Summer 2002), the Country Club of Jackson recently hosted the 2002 Michigan Amateur. It has been home to the Wendy's Charity Golf Classic LPGA Pro-Am since its inception in 1999.

Funds generated by the Wendy's Charity Golf Classic helped start and now help maintain the Adoption Resource Center.

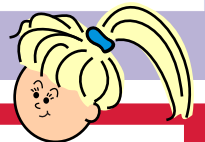
